

Net Control Script for QCWA Chapter 91 Weekly Net

Opening

Good morning. Welcome to the Washington DC area Quarter Century Wireless Association net sponsored by the Vic Clark Chapter 91. My name is [your name & call] and today we will be using the Vic Clark Chapter 91 call - W4QCW.

QCWA is an international organization of amateur radio operators who were licensed at least 25 years ago.

The purpose of this net is to share information about QCWA, the Vic Clark Chapter and amateur radio in general. It meets every Sunday morning at 9 o'clock local time on 146.91. In the event this frequency is not available, we will attempt to use the repeater on 146.79 MHz. The net will close no later than 10:30 this morning.

Historical note: this net was first held on Sunday, 16 September 1990

Before we begin, is there any time-sensitive traffic requiring the use of this repeater?

Check-ins

Let's get check-ins. If you are a short timer, so indicate. All amateurs are welcome.

Let's go to the short-timers for their comments:

Let's now go to the officers for any announcements or other Chapter 91 business:

If the control operator has selected a topic for discussion on this day's net, this is a good time to pose it so that people have a chance to think about their responses. Announce that we'll discuss it after the first round of comments has been completed.

Let's now get comments from our other check-ins:

After the first round of comments: This is W4QCW and the Sunday Morning QCWA Chapter 91 net. Any station wishing join us, please call now.

Repeat the list of the late check-ins and ask for their general comments.

Now proceed with discussion of today's topic, if any. When finished with the net, say:
This is W4QCW and the Sunday Morning QCWA Chapter 91 net. Before closing, are there any further comments for the net. If so, please call now.

Closing

That's it for today. We thank the Northern Virginia FM Association for the use of its repeater. We encourage you to support the NVFMA. Check into the association's on-air meetings Wednesdays at 8:00 p.m. The net control operator next week will be [name and call sign] [If in the net today, please ask to confirm.]
